- BSN degree and active RN license
- Completion of elementary statistics (minimum grade of C) by first class day
- 1,500 BSN practice hours before first clinical course

DOCTOR OF NURSING PRACTICE

Leadership, Forensic Nursing, Extreme Environment Nursing

- Graduate degree in nursing from a CCNE or NLNAC nationally accredited program and RN license
- Completion of elementary statistics (minimum grade of B) by first class day
- Completion of advanced pharmacology, advanced physical assessment and advanced pathophysiology (minimum grade of B) prior to admission.

Post-Graduate: • Graduate degree in nursing and RN license
Adult-Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner • Completion of elementary statistics (minimum grade of B) by first class day
